Yesterday, October 7, 2020, the Henry Viscardi School was notified that a student has tested positive for COVID-19. Since this student has been self-quarantining and out of school for an extended period of time, we will continue to follow the current hybrid schedule.

In accordance with Henry Viscardi School's reopening plan, the Nassau County Department of Health Services (DHS) has been notified, and the school assisted in its contact tracing efforts. Under the current circumstance, this student's extended absence, the DHS is not issuing student or staff quarantine orders. At this time it will not be necessary to close HVS. We will continue to follow all the necessary steps to mitigate exposure to any student or staff.

We share this information with you as part of our ongoing efforts to keep our community informed of COVID-related issues that affect the school environment. However, we must respect the laws relating to the privacy of our students and staff and, therefore, will not provide any additional details.
