Today, the Henry Viscardi School was notified that a staff member, who works on the elementary level, has tested positive for COVID-19. The staff member was last in school on November 20.

The Nassau County Department of Health was immediately notified to initiate a contact tracing investigation. Under the current circumstances, there was no exposure to anyone in the school in this case because the staff member has not been in school and was not infectious when last in school. Therefore, the DOH is not issuing student or staff quarantine orders.

Reminder, we will resume our hybrid schedule and return to in-person instruction on Monday, December 7.

Let me take this opportunity to remind everyone of the importance of the protocols that we have in place to keep everyone healthy and safe. Remember to complete the daily health screening survey and stay home when you do not feel well. These protocols are especially important to follow as we approach the winter months and cases are on the rise in our region.
