With the development of the vaccine and as COVID rates decline, there is optimism for our future returning to a new normal.

Our Extended School Year (ESY) Summer Program begins Tuesday, July 6th. We are happy to announce that we will be offering five (5) days of in-person instruction for the summer program; however, this is subject to change based on NYSED, DOH, and/or HVS COVID issues. We are also happy to announce, Ms. Kim Albrecht will be the ESY summer principal. Attached, you will find the ESY summer program letter that must be returned indicating if your child will attend the summer program and if your child will be attending five (5) days in-person or attending fully remote.

As a reminder, Spring Break begins Monday, March 29th, through Wednesday, April 7th. If you are planning to travel during this time, you must adhere to the New York State Travel Advisory and quarantine requirements for travelers, <https://coronavirus.health.ny.gov/covid-19-travel-advisory>. During this time, staff and students must continue to report if they become COVID positive or are deemed a direct contact to HVS Administration. If there are any updates or changes to the travel advisory, we will be sure to inform you as we become aware.
