Dear Henry Viscardi School Community:

Today, the Henry Viscardi School was notified that a student has tested positive for COVID-19. The student was last in school on Monday, May 10. The Nassau County Department of Health (DOH) has been notified, and the school is assisting in its contact tracing efforts. The school's administration and medical department already informed those who are identified as being a close contact. Therefore, if you were not directly contacted, you were not deemed a close contact. Official quarantine orders will be issued by the DOH in the ensuing days. Any staff member and/or student who is directed to quarantine will return to HVS only when released to do so by the Department of Health.

The Henry Viscardi School was also notified that a staff member has tested positive for COVID-19. There was no exposure to anyone in the school in this case because the staff member has not been in school. Therefore, the DOH is not issuing student or staff quarantine orders related to this case.

Let me take this opportunity to remind everyone of the importance of the protocols that we have in place to keep everyone healthy and safe. Remember to complete the daily health screening survey and stay home when you do not feel well. As always, we will continue to follow all thorough building sanitizing, disinfecting, and cleaning protocols on a daily basis.
